If placards cannot be made available before the students are due to arrive, please instruct them to park in the Lake Grove Church Baptist 265 Leath Street lot until they are received. PLEASE DO NOT INSTRUCT STUDENTS TO PARK IN THE OPC GARAGE LOCATED AT 777 WASHINGTON BEFORE PARKING PLACARDS ARE ISSUED.

 result in their receiving a parking citation and/or a boot.
